

(1) LEGAL AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON CHILD FRIENDLY LEGAL SERVICES TO CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL FOCUS ON PREVENTIVE ASPECTS ON SEXUAL OFFENCE

Date & Time: April 2025 - March 2026 (various localities of Aizawl)

Target group:

- (i) Local dwellers (parents, youths) including women and children.
- (ii) Church leaders, MHIP members etc.

As planned, programs were conducted in five (5) selected localities in Aizawl city, to promote awareness on child-friendly legal services for children with special emphasis on the preventive aspects of sexual offences at the grassroot level.

Two key topics were chosen:

1. Child-Friendly Legal Services for Children and their protection.
2. Roles and responsibilities of everyone present in ensuring child safety.

(2) LEGAL AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON CHILD FRIENDLY LEGAL SERVICES TO THE VICTIMS OF DRUG ABUSE AND ERADICATION OF DRUG MENACE

Date & Time: April 2025 - March 2026 (various localities of Aizawl)

Target group:

- (i) Local dwellers (parents, youths) including women and children.
- (ii) Local leaders Viz. Members of Local Councils, YMA leaders, Church leaders etc.
- (iii) Students of MZU, and Faculty members

As planned, programs were conducted in five (5) selected localities in Aizawl city, targeting grassroots-level communities to promote awareness on child-friendly legal services for victims of drug abuse, focusing on measures for the eradication of the drug menace.

Two key topics were chosen:

1. The importance of rehabilitation over punishment, and the responsibilities of youth in curbing the drug problem.
2. Role of legal institutions and public cooperation in addressing the root causes of drug addiction.

(3) LEGAL AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON MUNICIPAL LAWS RELATING TO THE PROTECTION OF THE MIZO COMMUNITY VIZ, THE BENGAL EASTERN FRONTIER REGULATION, 1873 (WITH GUIDELINES FOR ITS ENFORCEMENT) AND THE MIZORAM SCHEDULED TRIBES AND SCHEDULED CASTE (REGULATION OF ISSUANCE AND VERIFICATION OF COMMUNITY CERTIFICATES) ACT, 2014

Date & Time: April 2025 - March 2026

Target group:

- (i) Local dwellers (parents, youths) including women and children.
- (ii) Church leaders.

As planned, programs were conducted in two (2) selected localities in Aizawl city, targeting grassroots-level communities focusing on awareness of laws protecting the Mizo community.

Three key topics were chosen:

1. Laws related to the protection and preservation of the Mizo community.
2. Bengal Eastern Frontier Regulation (BEFR), 1873, including the mechanism of the Inner Line Permit (ILP) and guidelines for its proper enforcement.
3. The Mizoram Scheduled Tribes and Scheduled Castes (Regulation of Issuance and Verification of Community Certificates) Act, 2014.

(4) LEGAL AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON MUNICIPAL LAWS WITH REFERENCE TO THE AMC BUILDING REGULATIONS, 2012 AND THE AMC CONTROL OF PARKING AND COLLECTION OF PARKING FEES REGULATIONS, 2012

Date & Time: April 2025 - March 2026

Target group:

As planned, program was conducted in one (1) selected locality in Aizawl city, targeting communities that would benefit from awareness on municipal laws relating to building and parking regulations.

Two key topics were chosen:

1. The laws related to AMC Building Regulations, 2012.
2. Clarification on various issues related to AMC Control of Parking and Collection of Parking Fees Regulations, 2012.

(5) LEGAL AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON MIZO MARRIAGE, DIVORCE AND INHERITANCE WITH MIZO CUSTOMARY LAWS

As planned, programs were conducted in three (3) selected localities in Aizawl city, explaining the traditional practices and legal principles governing family relations and property succession in Mizo society.

Two key topics were chosen:

1. Mizo Marriage, Divorce and Inheritance of Property Act.
2. Mizo Customary Laws and their importance.

(6) LEGAL AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON CORRUPTION LAWS VIZ, THE PREVENTION OF CORRUPTION ACT, 1988; THE MIZORAM LOKAYUKTA ACT, 2014 AND THE MIZORAM LOKAYUKTA RULES, 2016

Date & Time: April 2025 - March 2026

Target group:

- (i) Local dwellers (parents, youths) including women and children.
- (ii) Church leaders.

As planned, program was conducted in one (1) selected locality in Aizawl city, to create awareness among the communities about the corruption laws and the role of the Lok Ayukta in addressing corruption.

Three key topics were chosen:

1. Principal of anti-corruption laws operating in India and Mizoram.
2. Rights and duties of public servants under the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988.
3. Structure, powers, and procedures of the Mizoram Lokayukta.

(7) LEGAL AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON FOREIGNER LAWS VIZ, THE FOREIGNERS ACT, 1946, THE FOREIGNERS (RESTRICTED AREAS) ORDER, 1948, INDIAN PASSPORT ACT, 1920, PASSPORT (ENTRY INTO INDIA) RULES, 1950, FOREIGNERS ORDER, 1948, FOREIGNERS (PROTECTED AREAS) ORDER, 1958 AND THE FOREIGNERS (REPORT TO POLICE) ORDER, 1971 ETC

2. Key legislations including the Foreigners Act, 1946, the Foreigners (Restricted Areas) Order, 1948, Indian Passport Act, 1920, Passport (Entry into India) Rules, 1950, Foreigners Order, 1948, Foreigners (Protected Areas) Order, 1958, and the Foreigners (Report to Police) Order, 1971.

(8) LEGAL AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON CONSUMER PROTECTION ACT, 2019 WITH ITS RULES AND REGULATIONS

Two key topics were chosen:

1. The Consumer Protection Act, 2019 with its rules and regulations.

2. The functioning of Consumer Commission and the new Central Consumer Protection Authority (CCPA).

(9) LEGAL AWARENESS ON URBAN GOVERNANCE IN MIZORAM WITH REFERENCE TO THE MIZORAM MUNICIPALITIES ACT, 2007 AND THE MIZORAM MUNICIPALITIES (WARD COMMITTEE AND LOCAL COUNCIL) RULES, 2010

2. Urban Governance in Mizoram.

(10) LEGAL AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON RELEVANT PROVISIONS OF THE MIZORAM LIQUOR(PROHIBITION) ACT, 2019 AND ND&PS ACT

As planned, program was conducted in one (1) selected locality in Aizawl city, to create awareness on the rights of children and the legal safeguards available for their protection.

Two key topics were chosen:

1. Creating a safe and supportive environment for children.
2. Roles and responsibilities of every individual in ensuring child safety.
